# Royal Aeronautical Society Grades of Membership

The table below provides guidance to officers at which grade of membership applications should be made. The Society's grading structure does not bear a strict relationship to the armed forces ranks, but the typical profile of officers in these ranks has been assessed as normally meeting the requirements for the grade indicated. Please note that all applicants are required to have held their current and correct rank for at least two years at the time of application. If you are in any doubt or require further guidance, please contact the Society (contact details overleaf).

Engineering officers may also be interested in registration as a Chartered or Incorporated Engineer with the Engineering Council (UK). Further information and guidance is available on the procedures involved; please indicate overleaf if this is something you wish to pursue.

Applications for both RAeS membership and EC(UK) registration are considered by the relevant grading committee on a bi-monthly basis. It may, therefore, take up to three months to process an application, depending upon when it arrives in relation to the committees' meeting cycle.

Please note that, whilst RAeS staff may provide advice and guidance with regard to the application process, all membership and registration decisions are made by the appropriate grading committee.
