AVM Margaret STAIB AM CSC – An Overview

AVM Staib commenced in the role of CEO at Airservices on 15th October 2012 after a distinguished career over three decades in the Royal Australian Air Force. From January 2010, she held the position of Commander Joint Logistics. In 2000, AVM Staib's contribution and leadership in the field of ADF Aviation Inventory Management was recognised when she was awarded the Conspicuous Service Cross. She was a member of the Chief of Air Force Advisory Committee. A posting with the United States Air Force at the Pentagon furthered her experience of logistics transformation, including strategic procurement initiatives with industry, supply chain integration and technology. Her service during this period was recognised with the United States Meritorious Service Medal.

In January 2009, she was appointed as a Member in the Military Division of the Order of Australia and was also recognised by Australian industry when she

received the Outstanding Contribution to Supply Chain Management in Australia award at the 2011 Smart Supply Chain Conference.

AVM Staib is a member of the Industry Advisory Board for the Centre for Aeronautical & Aviation Leadership of Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, a member of the Industry Advisory Board for the RMIT University School of Aerospace, Mechanical & Manufacturing Engineering and holds the rank of Air Vice Marshal in the Royal Australian Air Force Active Reserve
